Web2. Gait (casual, heel, toe, tandem) 3. Truncal stability (vermis) and Romberg test (proprioception) 4. Functional motor testing a. Lower limbs - arise from a squat (or a chair with arms folded) b. Upper limbs - raise arms above head 5. Visual fields, pupils and eye movements 6. Motor exam a. Pronator drift b. Finger-to-nose testing with eyes closed
